Champaign County Fair Hosts Buckeye Stallion Series

August 7th was a big night at the Champaign County Fair in the grandstand with 2-year-old pacers and trotters racing in the third leg of the Buckeye Stallion Series.

There were five divisions of 2-year-old colt pacers. Unlikeanyother (Pet Rock-Scootin Mercedes) made his second Buckeye Stallion Series win in Race 3. Chris Page drove, coming home in 1:59.2. Unlikeanyother is trained by Sophie Desroches and owned by Frommling Properties LLC and Kerry Frommling. His breeder is Jane Glass. Bllack Hole (Mr Apples-Feel The Thunder) was second and Dragon Purplechips (Dragon Again-Open Forum) was third.

Ohio Vintage (Western Vintage - Little Betty) took the win in Race 7 in 1:56.4. Ohio Vintage was driven by Dan Noble and trained by C. Brian Loney for owner and breeder Ribbonships. Woody Woodpecker (Woodstock-Townline Rosanna) was second and Wrongswhatidobest (McArdle-Metallico) was third.

Caviart Cooper (Dragon Again-Caviart Callie) and driver Kayne Kauffman came to the winner's circle in 1:57.4 in Race 10, followed by Heerz Socked Up (Western Vintage-Pearl Berley) and Rockette Baby (Big Bad John-O Narutac Rockette). Caviart Cooper is trained by Jim Arledge Jr. and owned and bred by Caviart Farms.

Bom Bay Rock (Pet Rock-Four Starzz Hope) took the lead in the 14th race with driver Tyler Smith. They came home in 1:59.1 while another Pet Rock colt, On The Rocksplease (Pet Rock-Slice Of Life) followed close behind in second. Third was Big Pocket Teen (Mister Big-Beautinaful). Bom Bay Rock is trained by Timothy Wilson Jr, owned by Wilson Racing Stable Inc and Norman Neff and bred by Walter Fister LLC.

The final 2-year-old colt pace division was in Race 19 when Yankee Boots (Yankee Cruiser-Boots N Saddle) won for the third leg in a row! He was driven to the wire by Elliott Deaton and is trained by Steve Carter. Owners of Yankee Boots include Peggy Carter, Chuck Grubbs, Steve Carter and Joseph Whitacre. Yankee Boots is also bred by Peggy Carter, Grubbs and Whitacre as well as Robert B Reid Estate. Zip Zip Will (We Will See- Zip Zip Boom) followed in second and Jimmy Ray Lou (Mister Big-Traceyannekillen) was third.

The 2-year-old trotter colts also raced in five divisions, with Stars An Stones (Wishing Stone- A Star For Sidney) winning the colt trot race during Race 6 in 2:02.2, driven by Cameron McCown. Chris Beaver trains the colt who is owned and bred by Myron Yoder. Following was Workinitonbroadway (Broadway Hall-Working Girl) in second and Dynamic Ridge (Uncle Peter-Frannie's Ridge) in third.

Another Wishing Stone colt won Race 8 when Sv Payton Place (Wishing Stone-Miss Payton) took his second Buckeye Stallion Series win. He finished in 2:02.4 with Chris Page in the sulky. Chris Beaver owns and trains the colt. Other owners include Shelly Pfeiffer, Leo Fleming and Steven Zeehandelar. Spring Valley Farm is the breeder. Second place was Seal Sniper (Dejarmbro-Valley Of Dreams) and third was Wishing Money (Wishing Stone-The Lady Money).

Luckycompeter (Uncle Peter-Lucky Billie) had a lucky evening when he finished first in 2:07.2 in Race 11 with driver Cameron McCown. He is trained by Chris Beaver, who is also an owner. Other owners include Martin Yoder and Steve Zeehandelar. Luckeycompeter is bred by Bill Troyer. Following in second and third was Wish For Gold (Wishing Stone-Adriana Hanover) and Surprize Mission (Manofmanymissions-Prize Chip).

Dontyouforget it is the sire of the top two finishers in Race 15. Voyage To Paris (Dontyouforgetit-Paris Hall) was first followed by Emerald Eyes (Dontyouforgetit-Emerald Myway). Driver Jack Dailey took Voyage to Paris to the wire in

2:01.3. He is trained by Jim Pollack, Jr. Steven Richard and Lana Pollack are his owners and he is bred by Joseph Miller. Third was Gallivant (Triumphant Caviar-Hollys Diamond).

Race 17 was the final race of 2-year-old trotting colts. Roscoe Village (Broadway Hall-Abbey Craig) took the win in 2:02.4 with Hall N Bro (Dejarmbro-Hall-n-flori) a close second. Roscoe Village was driven by Chris Page. He is trained and owned by Chris Beaver. Martin Yoder and Steven Zeehandelar also own the colt. He is bred by Steve Steward and Martti Ala-Seppala. Majesty Boy (Triumphant Caviar-See Her Majesty) was third.

There were four divisions in the 2-year-old filly pacers. My Hearts Rockin (Rockin Amadeus-My Sweet Lorelei) won Race 5 in 1:59.1 with Dan Noble in the sulky, trained by C. Brian Loney. The Rockin Amadeus filly is owned and bred by James Joyner. Second and third were close with Nativeandup (Allamerican Native-Ain't Given Up) followed by Feelinupbeat (Feelin Friskie-Last Sam Standing).

Race 9 saw Atlantic Star (Cheyenne Rei-Atlantic Filly) back in the winner's circle, after winning in leg 2 on July 19th. Ed Hennessey headed her to the winner's circle in 1:59.1. She is trained by Sandra Hennessey, owned by Michael Hale and Don Locricchio and bred by Ohio State ATI. Dragonfly (Dragon Again-Win D Won) followed her in second and New Number Who Dis (Shark Gesture-Nothings Ever Free) finished third.

Cookies Empire (Pet Rock-La Diavla) is also no stranger to the Buckeye Stallion Series winner's circle. She won Race 13 and was also a winner in the first leg on July 10th. Tyler Smith guided her to the finish in 2:00.2. She is trained and owned by Steve Carter. Midland Acres Inc. is the breeder. Closely behind her in second and third were Bet You Im Rockin (Rockin Amadeus-Zabette) and Lluli (Mr Apples-Chloes Silver Star).

The final 2-year-old filly pace race was Race 18. Pet Rock sired all three top finishers. Ifeellikesassy (Pet Rock-Ifeellikelaughing) finished in 1:59.2 with driver Cameron McCown, trained by Ron Potter. She is owned and bred by Last Laugh LLC. A close second and third went to Pappy Rocks (Pet Rock-Hokie Heart) and Smartys Filly (Pet Rock-Smartygirl).

There were three divisions of 2-filly-trotters. Supreme Lady (Knight Of Intrigue-Open The Case) won Race 4 in 2:02.4, driven by Don Irvine Jr. and trained by Rosy Weaver. She is owned by First Up Racing Stable and bred by Harry Yoder. She's Lovely (Neely Dunn-She's Queenie) finished second and Wontcatchginnyc (Dontyouforgetit-For Heathers Sake) was third.

Ladycallstheshots (Uncle Peter-Caviar Forthe Lady) won Race 12 with Tyler Smith in the sulky in 2:02.2. Marty Wollam trains and Acadia Farms Inc. is the owner and breeder. Fingerinthefrostin (Stormin Normand-Action On Lavec) was second. Another Uncle Peter filly, Making Dreams (Uncle Peter-Silly Dreams) was third.

Gayla Kaye (Dejarmbro-Ticket To Glide) won Race 16 in 2:05.0 with driver Dan Noble. She is trained by John Ryan Melsheimer and owned and bred by Joyce McClelland. Shes Got Bling (Uncle Peter-Rosa Parks) was second and Two For You (Dontyouforgetit-Eastern Star Two) was third.

The next leg for both 2-and 3-year-olds in a Buckeye Stallion Series will be for the forth leg at the Delaware County Fair September 16, 17, 19 and 20.
