Buckeye Stallion Series Results from Wednesday July 18

Eldorado Scioto Downs hosted two divisions of Buckeye Stallion Series Wednesday afternoon (July 18), the 3-year-old filly trotters and 2-year-old colt trotters.

The 3-year-old filly trotters were Race 1 and 3. Nice And Shiny As (Stormin Normand-Follonica) came home in 1:57.1 with Chris Page in the sulky for trainer Annette Lorentzon. She also won her Buckeye Stallion Series division on June 12. She is owned and bred by ACL Stuteri AB. Close behind in second and third were This Year's Best (My MVP-Under My Thumb) in 1:57.1 and Bugs MVP (My MVP-Char Catie Becca) in 1:57.2.

Kellie's MVP (My MVP-Adriana Hanover) won Race 3 in 1:57.2, driven and trained by Ray Paver. She also won her Buckeye Stallion Series division on June 12. She is owned by Samuel Raneri and Raymond Tom Paver, bred by Kevin Kline and Derek Jacobus. Second place in 1:57.3 was Proxierigs (Big Rigs-Proxie Promised) and third in 1:57.4 was Destarofnight (Dejarmbro-Eastern Star Two).

The 2-year-old colt trotters were in Race 2, 5 and 7. Chris Page won his second Buckeye Stallion Series of the afternoon when he drove Sv Payton Place (Wishing Stone-Miss Payton) to the finish in 2:01.2. Sv Payton Place is trained and owned by Christopher Beavers. Other owners of Sv Payton include Shelly Pfeiffer, Leo V Fleming and Steven Zeehandelaar. Spring Valley Farm is the breeder. Close behind were two Uncle Peter colts, Master Marlin (Uncle Peter-Pinup Springs) in 2:01.2 and Dynamic Ridge (Uncle Peter-Frannie's Ridge) in 2:01.4.

Ray Paver made his second trip to the winner's circle with Buckeyeonbroadway (Dejarmbro-Dream on Broadway), finishing in 2:01.0. Jeff Conger trains. This colt also won the Buckeye Stallion Series on July 3. He is owned and bred by Denise Dennis and Dolne Farm Services LLC. Finishing second was Roscoe Village (Broadway Hall-Abbey Craig) in 2:01.2 and Blazinberries (Neely Dunn-Chippednstrawberry) 2:02.0 placed third.

Joe Gotto Go (Neely Dunn-My Chere) and driver Chris Page had to go to the winner's circle after finishing in 1:59.1. This is the colt's second Buckeye Stallion Series win this month, winning on July 3. Joe Gotta Go is trained by Donald Gibson. His owners are Mike Davison and Gary Crumrin and bred by Fred Polk. Close behind in second was Count's Chip (Full Count-Smart Chip) in 1:59.1 and Stars An Stones finished third in 2:00.1.

Buckeye Stallion Series continues at Eldorado Scioto Downs on July 21 with the 3-year-old colt pacers.
